

SAMPLE SURFACE DOCUMENTATION

An attempt was made by PET members to locate and document Apollo 11 samples in EVA photographs. However, because of the time constraints placed on the astronauts, very few photographs were taken of samples as they lay on the lunar surface. Subsequently, tentative identification of some samples were made from photographs taken from LEM view ports.

The Apollo 11 preliminary science report (NASA SP-214) documents what data and photographs were available, but offer little concrete proof of documented samples as they lay on the lunar surface.
