<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 67558 is a light gray, moderately friable breccia with light and dark clasts (Fig. 1). The clasts include both aphanitic and crystalline rock fragments. It is a rake sample collected near the White Breccia boulders and has a few zap pits on all surfaces.
