


FIGURE 1. Smallest scale division in mm. S-72-49575.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 67765 is a coherent, dark gray, crystalline breccia which is homogeneous but with a white rind over part of its surface (Fig. 1). The matrix has no obvious clasts. It is a rake sample collected halfway between the White Breccia boulders and House Rock, and lacks zap pits.
