<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 67767 is a white, homogeneous, friable breccia (Fig. 1) which is fine-grained and lacks obvious clasts. A few yellow to gray mineral grains are present. The fragment might be a pure, friable cataclastic anorthosite. It is a rake sample collected halfway between the White Breccia boulders and House Rock.
